Extracurricular Eligibility Policy

At CVMS, we appreciate your hard work and the extra time you put in at practices, games, meets, and competitions. You represent our school community well by working hard in your activities and academics.

We want to ensure that each player/participant understands our extracurricular policy regarding eligibility to participate in extracurricular activities. Student-athletes/participants represent all of us at Canyon View Middle School, and because of that, you have a greater responsibility. The school's Academic Probation, Citizenship Probation, and Attendance policies are enforced with our extracurricular student participants. In addition, each extracurricular participant must have and maintain grades, citizenship, and attendance that do not fall on our low achievement list or attendance watch list. This means student-athletes with any Fs, Us, two or more Ds, or two or more Ns will be given one week of warning, followed by one week of ineligibility. Any unexcused absence will be treated the same as an F or U, putting the student on a "warning week"; any subsequent unexcused absence will make the student ineligible. In addition, athletes MUST attend school on the SAME game day to be eligible.

Only eligible athletes can participate, sit on the bench, or travel with the team to the game, meet, or competition that week. Student-athletes are expected to attend practices while working to improve academic and citizenship grades. Coaches are updated on student extracurricular eligibility; parents and students can check grades anytime through Aspire.

Academic and citizenship grades are checked every Friday morning. If a student-athlete does not meet the requirements, they will receive a warning email letting them know they will be on a "warning week" the following week. They will have until Friday to remediate those grades, or they will be ineligible for the following week. They must remediate grades to be eligible moving forward.
